1. Stop surplus ordering at a cost to the church.
2. Encourage members to give contact details to send out reminder emails/texts so they do not miss out on receiving their quarterlies, as we will not order surplus.
3. 10-minute spot once a month to promote books/media for Literature Evangelism and Bible Study.

List the major achievements of your Department/Ministry for this period:

1. We have set up an ABC satellite shop for Church members, regular visitors and departments allowing members to have easy access to literature which assists them to serve and evangelise to family, friends and their communities.
2. Since the ABC satellite opened in October 2016 we have sold over £1,600 worth of products with 10% of the proceeds going to our PM department. This is a huge achievement considering we have no premises to work from and we've been limited to 2 book sales since starting last year. This shows there is a real need and appreciation for this service.
3. We have balanced all accounts sent the information to the treasury with clear transparent records and all invoices accounted for. Our account is credit.
4. We no longer order surplus books which saves the church money.
5. We've helped reduced Sabbath School and other departments post and packing payments, which were considerable by setting up ABC shop.

List the major plans of your Department/Ministry for next quarter:

1. To partner with other church departments to ensure the media we purchase and promote supports their plans and programmes throughout the year. Sabbath School has always been well catered for, but we aim to extend that tailored support to Family Life, Stewardship, Education, etc.

We will do this by setting monthly challenges for each Sabbath school class to study designated books of the bible and impart/share that knowledge with the church. Over an 8 month period, the church will have a deeper knowledge of various books in the bible
3. Encourage whole church participation to increase attendance at Sabbath School – (In-Reach)
 - Frequent reminders of Sabbath school start time and recognition for early attendance
 - Families allocated various programmes
 - Independence Day - different represented countries facilitating Sabbath school programmes

- Allocating Sabbath school programmes to various classes
- Birthday recognition at the end of each month

4. Visit and phone members missing from Sabbath school for more than 2 weeks –

- Place and emphasis on teachers to make note of members missing for more than 2 weeks and report this to the Sabbath School team.
- Sabbath school team follows up with a phone call and visit.

5. Visitation Programme:

- A dedicated Sabbath school Superintendent is allocated the visitation programme.
- Superintendent will work with Elders to arrange visits to members who are unable to attend church due to illnesses etc.
