List the major achievements for your department/ministry since the start of 2016

- 1. Since the start of the year the team have met on a number of occasions to plan and establish goals.
- 2. An opportunity was offered to all young people to come and share their views and opinions with the AYS team in an effort to include their ideas and contributions to the overall plans of the department. It was also intended to fully solicit and engage their interest in the work of the youth department.
- 3. We have begun the task of allocating young people into ALSO groups in preparation for the youth Challenge
- 4. 22nd January first youth social for the year Can't cook, Wont Cook!

List the Goals for your Department/Ministry for the year:

1. Evangelism, Everyone. Everywhere

We have decided to use the SEC theme as the focus for youth ministries. This will involve supporting young people to engage in evangelistic in reach. This may involve a Daniel and Revelation seminar, participating in the work of other community projects, church departments and by reaching out to young people who are no longer attending church.

- 2. We aim to actively seek to engage young people in church programmes and activities to maintain their interest and involvement.
- 3. We will be working towards baptising a minimum of 5 young people.

- 4. Assisting young people to develop their leadership skills and abilities as well as cultivate their attentiveness to spiritual matters. Each youth group will be allocated two mentors who will form part of a support network as well as to act as a spiritual guardian. Mentors will be briefed and receive basic training before commencing this important work.
- 5. Plan a Youth Retreat (weekend)

List the major plans of your Department/Ministry for next quarter:

- 1. To engage young people in active youth ministry within and outside of the department/church
- 2. To arrange an AYS programme to be presented at another SDA church or to invite a church to bring in an AYS programme to Luton Central
- 3. To organise the young people to work in groups to deliver AYS programmes, youth week of prayer and other key activities
- 4. To commence the process of initiating contact and developing relationships with young people in church who maybe currently experiencing isolation and disaffection as well as to reach out to those who no longer attend church.
- 5. To advocate for and contribute to building a community that fosters respect and interest in the spiritual, physical and mental development of the young people in Luton Central.

Comments:

Throughout the next 6 months, the youth department will be organising a youth challenge to encourage our young people to develop key leadership skills by means of active participation, supporting church projects, working together, embracing spiritual needs via personal and group study. Young people are expected to participate in a 6 month youth challenge whereby they will be tested on their skills of engagement, ability to plan, organise, engage, present, work in partnership with one another and with other church/community departments. The youth will receive support, guidance and where possible training may be considered, provided there is a budget to offer this provision.
